



Activity and lesson outline for pre-k. Class

- Monday, April 3:** Pre-k. Classes are invited to and Easter egg hunt at the Lehighton park, hosted by the residents of the Lehighton High Rise. Classes will be combined for this event. The hunt will begin at 11:00 in the park. Please see your special note (with Easter egg border), with all the information.
- Tuesday, April 4:** Easter party snack sign up sheet will be posted on the bulletin board. Today we will explore shapes and textures with play doh.
- Wednesday, April 5:** School picture day! Please be sure that the children arrive at school on time and camera ready! Please see the note and order form from PSP photographers with all the ordering information. Send your order form and payment to school with your child on picture day.
- Monday, April 10:** Worship in the sanctuary. One egg, two eggs, I see blue eggs! My Big World will help us learn about hatching. The children will make a hatching Easter egg during table work time.
- Tuesday, April 11:** We'll be getting ready for our Easter party, by decorating our Easter baskets for tomorrow's preschool egg hunt.
- Wednesday, April 12:** Today we will have our Easter parties! We'll have some hopping good fun and maybe an Easter egg hunt too!
- Monday, April 17:** Preschool closed for Easter vacation.
- Tuesday, April 18:** We'll be doing some farming this week as we explore eggs hatching and ducks quacking. We will use the song 'Scratch, Scratch' from our Scholastic cd to help count out as a poor farmer loses eggs as they become hatching chicks.
- Wednesday, April 19:** Down on the Farm, by Merrily Kutner is one of my favorite farm books. The animals on the farm all rock and roll and have a wonderful time. We will also count 5 little ducks that went out one day, over the hill and far away.....to help us do some counting and number work.
- Monday, April 24:** This week we will talk about how things grow. On one of the days this week, we are expecting delivery of tree seedlings from the PA Game Commission for each child in the preschool. We will have a lesson on how to care for our trees and what wonderful things trees do for our world. Since I'm not sure when the seedlings will arrive, I am listing the activity for today, but that may change depending on when we get the baby trees.
- Tuesday, April 25:** Grow Flower, Grow! By Lisa Bruce is our story for today. We'll help Fran and Fred as they learn what a plant needs to be healthy, then we'll make Earth Buddies!
- Wednesday, April 26:** Show & tell day. The last preschool newsletter, activity outline and snack calendars go home today.
