September

**Jack and Jill Preschool inclement weather policy
2017-2018 preschool term.**

If the Lehigh Area School District (LASD) cancels classes for the day due to bad weather, there will be NO classes at Jack and Jill Preschool for that day for either morning or afternoon classes no matter if they are pre-kindergarten or primary students.

If LASD closes early due to bad weather, there will be NO afternoon classes at Jack and Jill Preschool for that day for either pre-kindergarten or primary students.

If LASD has a bad weather late start:

And your child is in a prekindergarten class:

There will be NO morning pre-k. class that day. HOWEVER, there WILL be a combined morning and afternoon prekindergarten class that day during the regular afternoon prekindergarten class time. That means all pre-kindergarten students can attend class from 12:00-2:15 that day.

If your child attends the primary class and there is a bad weather late start:

There will be a one hour late start that day. Primary class children should come to preschool from 10:00-12:00 on a bad weather late start day.

Class hours may be extended, or days may be added to the preschool term and the Closing Program date may be moved forward if it is necessary to add a significant number of snow make-up days to the term.

These dates do not include any Parent's Organization Family Fun events. Representatives from the Parent Org. will be responsible for scheduling their events.
